Year 6: Autumn Term 1

English

To start the year, we will be writing our own short stories to entertain and to create a vivid picture for the reader with a focus on developing atmosphere. Skellig will be used as a stimulus.

Beyond this, we will have a focus on nonfiction and the children will create a balanced argument on homeschooling - using Mina as a reference.

To complete the half term in English, Year 6 will have a poetry focus, using 'The Owl and the Pussycat', 'The Listeners', 'The Highwayman' as stimuli.

Maths

To begin with, we shall be revisiting and embedding Place Value knowledge and understanding as well as developing their understanding of place value in numbers up to 10 million. The children will also have the opportunity to compare and round numbers. Following on from this, we will be having a focus on the four operations of addition, subtraction, division and multiplication.

We will then move on to investigating fractions. As well as reinforcing previously taught content, the children will be introduced to multiplying and dividing fractions by integers.

Curriculum Overview

Our new topic asks the question, 'Was Titus Salt good for Bradford?'. This will allow the children to develop their understanding of some important local history, whilst exploring what life would have been like during the Victorian Era.

In History, we will be looking at the development of Bradford during the industrial revolution and the significant impact this had. In PSHE, the focus is 'Being Me in My World' which includes, identifying goals for the year, children's universal rights, choices, consequences and rewards and democracy, having a voice. In R.E., we are going to be exploring how Sikhs show commitment by studying their values and we will also be comparing beliefs and ways of life with those of other faiths.
