Year 4: Autumn 1

English

In English this half term, we will be focusing on an explanation text about what makes a good teacher, this links in with our reading text 'Matilda'. We will be focusing on subordinating conjunctions, fronted adverbials and understanding how to use effect and tone in our writing. In our reading skills lessons, we will be reading 'Matilda" as our non-fiction text to better our inference skills, and retrieval skills. We are also super excited to be going to see the musical Matilda at the Alambra in November.

Maths

This half term, pupils will explore the place value of numbers up to 1000. This will be done by understanding the value of each digit in a 3-digit number. This will help the children develop their skills of both ordering and comparing 3-digit numbers. We will then go on to have a look at numbers up to 10,000 on a number line, rounding numbers, looking at negative numbers and finally, exploring Roman numerals.

We would ask that you help your child, every night for at least 10 minutes, with their learning of times tables. The children will be taking part **in a times tables test in June**. This is a speed test of random timetables to be completed on the computer so the more practice they have, the better their score is likely to be.





Curriculum Overview

Our focus for the Autumn term is History and more specifically how to use timelines effectively to compare time periods; the discovery of democracy; learn how different citystates interacted with each other; and finally, discuss how current European culture has been greatly influenced by Ancient Greeks.
