Year 2: Autumn Term 1

English

Phonics

In phonics we will be recapping our Set 1 sounds and learning Set 2 sounds and tricky words.

English

In our English lessons we are learning all about how to write sentences. We are learning about capital letters and full stops and how to separate words with spaces.

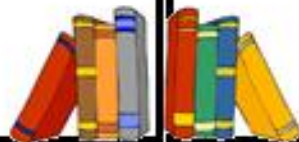
Reading

We are reading "Jack and the Beanstalk" by Mara Alperin and Mark Chambers.

Maths

Place Value: The pupils will learn to partition 2-digit numbers into tens and ones. They will learn to write numbers in words to 100.

Addition and Subtraction: The pupils will learn addition and subtraction fact families to 20 and investigate number bonds to 100. They will learn to add and subtract 2 digit and 1-digit numbers crossing 10.
