Year 2: Autumn Term 1

## English

#### **Phonics**

In phonics we will be recapping our Set 1 sounds and learning Set 2 sounds and tricky words.

### **English**

In our English lessons we are learning all about how to write sentences. We are learning about capital letters and full stops and how to separate words with spaces.

#### Reading

We are reading "Jach and the Beanstalk" by Mara Alperin and Mark Chambers.

## Maths

**Place Value:** The pupils will learn to partition 2-digit numbers into tens and ones. They will learn to write numbers in words to 100.

Addition and Subtraction: The pupils will learn addition and subtraction fact families to 20 and investigate number bonds to 100. They will learn to add and subtract 2 digit and 1-digit numbers crossing 10.
